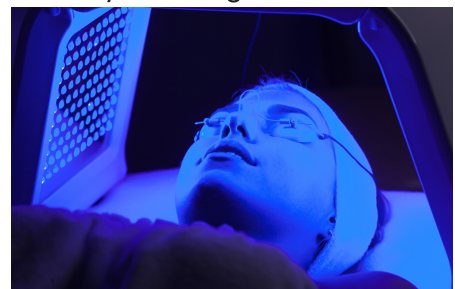

Red LED light improves the signs of ageing, such as wrinkles and fine lines by stimulating cells to produce collagen and elastin to smooth out the skin. Red light also reduces skin inflammation and scarring.

Results will vary but usually 10 x 20 minute treatments will reduce wrinkles and improve the quality of your skin by up to 60%.

Blue LED light reduces activity in the sebaceous glands to produce less oil and improve acne symptoms. It also kills a type of bacteria that contributes to acne by causing inflammation.
